THE MISSION OF THE DUE WEST FIRE & RESCUE DEPARTMENT

The mission of the Due West Fire & Rescue Department is to reduce frequency and severity of emergencies, by aggressively responding to all fires, high priority medical emergencies, and emergency incidents requiring DWFR response within the city limits and provide mutual aid to Abbeville County and other surrounding jurisdictions. The occupational safety and well-being of the personnel at the Due West Fire & Rescue Department is of utmost importance. In order to fulfill our mission these essential components must be in place: public fire safety education, fire code enforcement, progressive training, and work place safety.

DESCRIPTION OF DEPARTMENT

The Due West Fire And Rescue Department is responsible for fire suppression, vehicle extrication, emergency medical response, hazardous material operations and fire prevention and safety programs. This is done with 20 dedicated volunteers out of one station. The station houses 2 Engines, 1 Ladder Truck, 1 Brush Unit, and 1 Rescue Unit. We operate under an Automatic Aid Agreement with Abbeville County Fire and Mutual Aid Agreements with Anderson and Greenwood counties.





